## Privacy Policy

The Law Center ("we", "us", or "our") is committed to protecting your privacy. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, disclose, and safeguard your personal information when you visit thelawcenter.net or use our Services. Please read this policy carefully. By using our Website, you consent to the practices described here.

### 1. Information We Collect

We collect information you provide directly to us, including:

- Name and email address when you sign up for our free guide, email list, or newsletter
- Name, email, and payment information when you purchase a program such as the Family Court Custody Bootcamp
- Messages and information you submit through our Contact form
- Information you provide during coaching sessions or consultations

We also automatically collect certain information when you visit our Website, including:

- IP address and browser type
- Pages visited and time spent on the Website
- Referring website or source
- Cookie and tracking data (see Section 6 below)

### 2. How We Use Your Information

We use the information we collect to:

- Send you the free guide and educational resources you requested
- Deliver the programs and Services you purchased
- Send you email newsletters, educational content, and program updates (you may unsubscribe at any time)
- Respond to your questions, comments, or requests
- Process payments and manage your account
- Improve our Website, programs, and marketing
- Comply with legal obligations

### 3. Email Marketing

We use MailerLite to manage our email list and deliver email communications. When you subscribe to our list or purchase a program, your email address and name are stored in MailerLite. You can unsubscribe from our emails at any time by clicking the "Unsubscribe" link at the bottom of any email. We will not sell your email address to third parties.

#### **4. Payment Processing**

Purchases made through our Website are processed by ThriveCart, a third-party payment processor. We do not store your credit card or payment information on our servers. ThriveCart's privacy policy governs the handling of your payment data. We receive only confirmation of your purchase and the information needed to deliver your program.

#### **5. Sharing of Information**

We do not sell, trade, or rent your personal information to third parties. We may share your information with:

- Service providers who assist us in operating our Website and delivering our Services (such as MailerLite and ThriveCart), who are contractually obligated to keep your information confidential
- Law enforcement or government agencies if required by law or to protect our legal rights
- A successor entity in the event of a merger, acquisition, or sale of our business

#### **6. Cookies and Tracking**

Our Website uses cookies — small text files stored on your device — to improve your browsing experience, analyze site traffic, and support marketing functions. You can control cookie settings through your browser. Note that disabling cookies may affect the functionality of certain parts of our Website.

We may use Google Analytics to understand how visitors use our Website. Google Analytics collects anonymized usage data. You can opt out of Google Analytics tracking by using the Google Analytics Opt-Out Browser Add-on.

#### **7. Data Retention**

We retain your personal information for as long as necessary to provide you with our Services and to comply with our legal obligations. #### **8. Your Rights**

Depending on your location, you may have the following rights regarding your personal information:

- The right to access the personal information we hold about you

- The right to opt out of email marketing at any time
- California residents may have additional rights under the California Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA)
